Luxury vehicles are not about getting you from A to B. They're about caressing your soul and nourishing your spirit as you move.

Well, that's what it says in the brochure anyway. What is certainly true is that journeys go all the quicker if you're surrounded by the

finest nappa leather, hand-laid, polished mahogany and the greatest travel gadgets known to man. Or if you're going at 200mph.

Sail the seven seas

There may be many ways to get to Monaco – such as by car, rail or plane – but you know that, in fact, there is only one: in your own 95ft super-yacht. The spanking new **Princess 95MY (£900,000, www.princessyachts.com)** can accommodate ten passengers and four crew. Its twin 2400hp motors will propel it at up to 30 knots, which is pretty darned fast for something weighing 97 tonnes.



Get your bearings

So, you've got the car and the yacht, but little or no sense of direction. **Magellan's Crossover GPS (£300, www.magellangps.com)** is the solution. It'll direct you round the highways of the UK and Ireland with full postcode search, TMC (via an adaptor) and an MP3 player. But swap the SD card for nautical maps, and its IPX-4 waterproof design will come into its own, guiding your travels on the ocean waves.

Nothing sends out a stronger or clearer message about who you are than the car you drive. So, what message does the **Maserati GranTurismo (£70,000, www.granturismoisback.com)** transmit? It suggests that you're a sporty type who truly appreciates the roar of a 4.2l, 405hp engine. It implies that you're a gutsy type, more than willing to put its claimed 177mph top speed and 5.1s 0-60 time to the test. It proves that you have impeccable aesthetic tastes. It also pretty much guarantees that you're completely loaded.
